**“INSTRUCTIONS”**

**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL GAMES**

1. When playing as a team or partners, all players will draw numbers to determine teams or partners.
2. After teams or partners are determined, one player from each team or partners will draw to see where they are on the Game Chart. This applies to games of singles.
3. The **GAME CHART** (Brackets) will be used for all games.
4. The **GAME CHART** (Brackets) will be numbered in the first round of play.
5. Each team, partners or singles to determine who advances to the next round will play only one (1) game. Only the winner advances.
6. Once competition games starts, no one else can enter the competition. To participate in the competition, you must be present when the particular game starts.
7. Partners or teams cannot be changed once the particular game competition starts. If a member of the partners or teams are not present when they are scheduled to play, they forfeit their game. Any time partners, teams or individuals are not present when they are due to play they will forfeit their game. Always be present to play.
8. You must sign up for the game of your choice prior to the start of competition.
