

TENNESSEE GAME RULES
“WASHERS”

1. MATERIAL:

- a. Two (2) boards are required. Each board shall be 36 inches long and 16 inches wide. Each board will have three (3) 4 inch round holes.
 - i. The holes are located as follows: The center of all three (3) holes will be eight (8) inches from either side. The center of the first hole will be eight (8) inches from the end. The center of the second hole will be ten (10) inches from the center of the first hole. The center of the third hole will be ten (10) inches from the center of the second hold and eight (8) inches from the end of the board.
 - ii. The size of the holes will be four (4) inches.
 - iii. The boards will be hinged on one end and raised twelve (12) inches.
- b. Ten (10) washers are required. Five (5) washers marked with paint or something and the other five (5) washers marked with a different color or different markings. The washers will be 2 1/8 inches in diameter.
- c. The boards will be set twenty (20) feet apart, measuring from the front edge of each board. The game board shall have a twelve (12) inch rise from the front of each board to the back of the board.

2. PITCHING WASHERS:

- a. Players must stand behind the front line of the game board.
- b. Players pitch five (5) washers each, one at a time.
- c. For the first pitch, player may decide who pitches first by the toss of a coin. After that, the winner of that inning will pitch first.
- d. When there are only two (2) players, they will alternate ends after each round of play.
- e. When there are four (4) players, there will be two (2) players at each end.

3. SCORING:

- a. The game board is scored as follows:
 - i. 1st hole (closest to the ground) is 1 point
 - ii. 2nd hole (middle hole) is 2 points
 - iii. 3rd hole - (top hole) is 3 points
- b. All washers that go into the holes score. No cancellation of points.
- c. A regulation game shall be the first to get twenty-one (21) points or ten (10) innings which ever occurs first for a game of doubles. For singles, twenty-one (21) points or ten (10) innings which ever occurs first. When using the innings the one with the high score wins. If tied, one (1) inning will be pitched.
